People can reach out in many unique ways to support the communities in which they live. All of these efforts, in one way or another, have a profound effect upon families and children in our region. These are just a few examples of how our supporters have chosen to give back.

Metro Sign & Design

Thanks to Metro Sign & Design for their donation of a brand new outdoor sign at SERVE. The permanent sign incorporates the NVFS logo and color scheme, and is made of durable metal and plastic materials. This gift is just another instance of Metro Sign & Design's continued support of NVFS and SERVE's needs. They have also regularly provided signage for special events and other activities.

New Space - in the Nick of Time!

Our nationally recognized workforce development program, Training Futures, found itself in an impossible situation at year's end. Due to a building renovation, they were given just 60 days' notice to vacate the space

they had been operating in years. This change came just as they were about to begin a new 25-week curriculum with over four dozen students. The classes had to be delayed, and NVFS had to scramble to find a new space for Training Futures.

SAIC stepped in to prevent any further damage to our program and worked closely with NVFS in order to usher in a new era for Training Futures. With a larger space, just blocks away from their old location, Training Futures now enjoys a heavily subsidized lease in a location of better value for the program. For the first time in many years, they even have windows! Thanks to our Board member, J. Douglas Koelemay, and SAIC for making this possible with very little service disruption. Now, Training Futures has enough room to serve even more developing professionals.

The club supports several causes throughout the school year – Northern Virginia Family Service (NVFS), Timber Lane Elementary School, Leewood Nursing Home, Inova Fairfax Hospital for Children, Martha's Table, and VDOT. This past year the students have donated over 450 hours to our agency by organizing collection drives, participating in the Fannie Mae Help the Homeless Walkathon, and helping with our Back to School, Operation Turkey and Gifting for Families Drives. These kids are also great fundraisers for our agency and raised nearly \$1,500 for the Walkathon and over \$7,000 for our Holiday Drives. 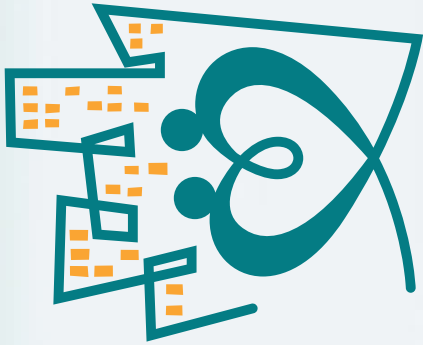
