### Internship Details:

- Training Futures will hold its three-week internship from Monday, Feb. 4, 2019 through Friday, Feb. 22, 2019.

Training Futures is a nationally recognized workforce development program with proven results, providing a critical pathway to living-wage jobs for high-potential, underemployed individuals.

- **75%** of program graduates, within six months of graduation, have found office jobs with the opportunity for advancement
- **79%** wage gain, within six months of graduation, compared with pre-training earnings

The six-month curriculum focuses on technical, administrative and computer skills while also teaching professional “soft” skills such as human relations and business telephone skills.
