



Stable Housing: The Foundation of Success

Access to stable housing is a basic necessity, but it can often be a struggle for many in our community. Stable housing is a foundation for success and self-sufficiency, and providing access to affordable housing to assist our neighbors in either becoming or remaining stably housed in Northern Virginia is a key goal of NVFS programs.

NVFS housing services are grounded in the Housing First model which emphasizes enlisting resources and support to make homelessness rare, brief, and non-recurrent. To achieve this, NVFS has a variety of programs aimed at providing support to those who are experiencing homelessness, including emergency shelter and case management.

NVFS also participates in a variety of collaborative, coalition-based programs with nonprofit and county agencies with the goal of preventing homelessness from occurring in the first place, including our <u>Bridging Affordability</u> and <u>Regional Assistance Housing Programs</u>. Through the combined efforts of NVFS, our partners and community members, our

collective mission to educate and support those in need continues to have an impact on our community.



We are recruiting Medicaid Enrollment Counselors!

Medicaid funding has been expanded and 400,000 more Virginians are eligible for Medicaid this year. NVFS is hosting a series of community events this spring to help people enroll in Medicaid and gain basic health literacy so the newly insured know how to use their insurance.
