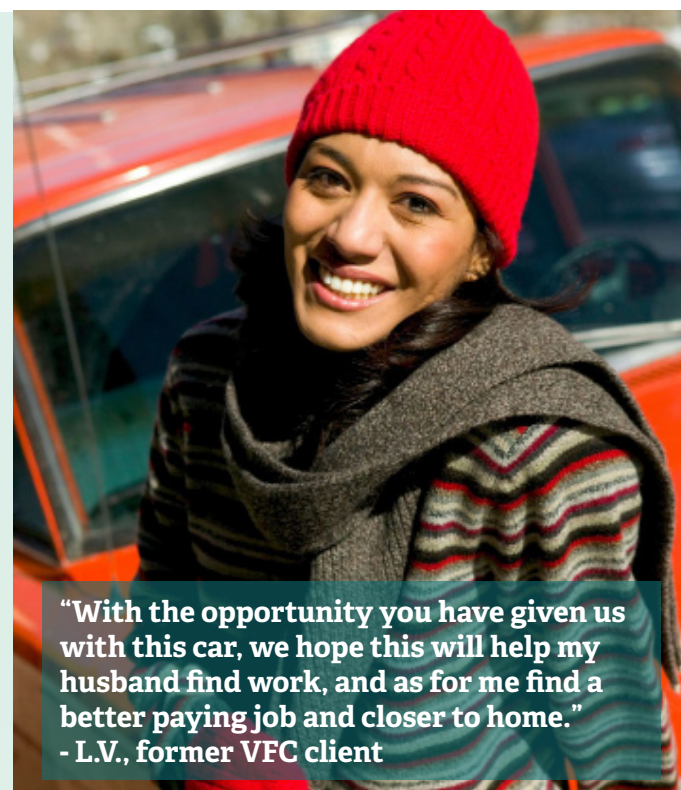

## Required Documents

- Completed Application
- Copies of the applicant's driver's license
- Identification for all children in the household (must contain dates of birth)
- Copy of car registration
- Verification of employment
- Quote/estimate from a mechanic
- Signed Appeals, Consent to Exchange Information, and Rights and Responsibilities Forms



Program partners include Vehicles for Change (Baltimore, Md.) and the Virginia Department of Social Services.

## Eligibility

Applicants must meet **ALL** of the following criteria in order to be eligible for assistance:

- Have low-income (income 200% or less of poverty level)
- Be employed a minimum of 30 hours per week for 4 weeks
- Have at least one child under the age of 18 (dependent minor)
- Be a resident of Northern Virginia
- Have a valid driver's license
- Own a vehicle in need of repairs
