Rising Costs & Holiday Stress

In the Northern Virginia region, the rising costs of day-to-day living are an ongoing challenge. Families have grappled with escalating prices over the past 18 months, with the cost of meeting basic needs — food, gas, childcare, and other essentials — steadily increasing. It's no surprise that the number of American adults struggling to make ends meet each month has increased, rising from 26.7% in 2021 to almost 40% in 2023. Many families have slipped into financial hardship, often having to face the difficult choice of paying for food, electricity, clothes for their children, or rent. This stress is compounded as the holidays approach and families look to celebrate and share joy through special meals or gifts.

To help relieve this burden and allow families to gather as they choose to during this season, Northern Virginia Family Service's Holiday Drives provide food, gift cards, toys and other gifts to more than 2,000 our of neighbors living in Arlington; Fairfax; Loudoun; and Prince William Counties; as well as the cities of Alexandria, Falls Church, Manassas, and Manassas Park. Eighty four percent of the households we work with live at or below the federal poverty level. NVFS' Holiday Drives ease the financial strain on local households, who would otherwise struggle to afford to celebrate their family traditions amidst rising costs.
