WHO

Families at 85% of the State Median Income (SMI) and 80% of Area Median Income (AMI)



WHAT

Supplemental reimbursement to support a 50% tuition reduction at a licensed private childcare facility, capped at \$9,000/year

Contact Us

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Preschool programs must:

-  Be in good standing with all VA State licensing requirements
-  Show examples of quality programming that includes:
 - Participation in the unified Virginia Quality Birth to Five system (VQB5)
 - If not a participant of VQB5, then must be using a research-based curriculum and offer ongoing professional development and training for teaching staff
 - Parent and teacher conferences on a scheduled, and regular, basis

Get started:

1. Childcare provider identifies potential families who may benefit from this opportunity.
2. Childcare provider confirms family's interest in participating in the Fee Reduction Program.
3. Childcare provider gives the family's contact information to the NVFS representative (contact info above).
4. NVFS follows up with the family and, if qualified, enrolls them in the Childcare Fee Reduction Program at your center.
5. Participating childcare providers are paid directly on behalf of the family. The minimum amount is \$750 a month with a max of \$9,000 annually.
